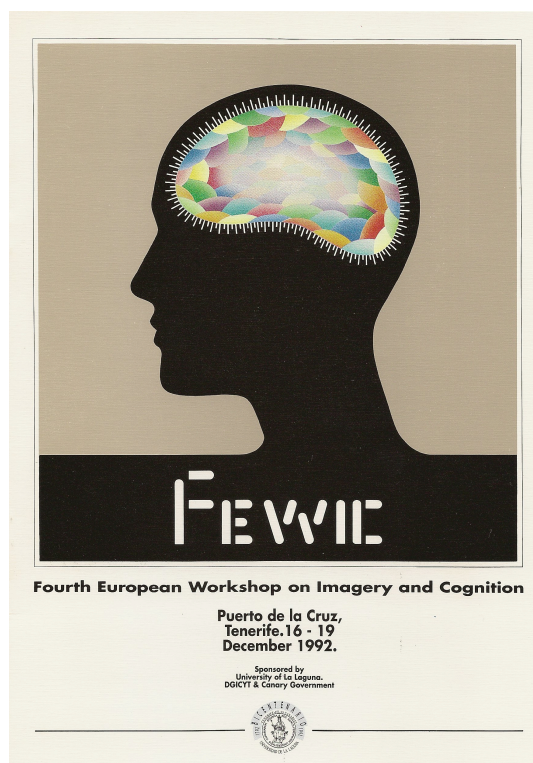
**La Laguna / Puerto de la Cruz

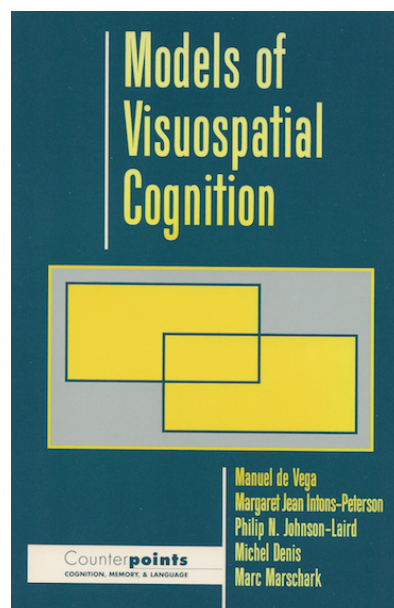
