

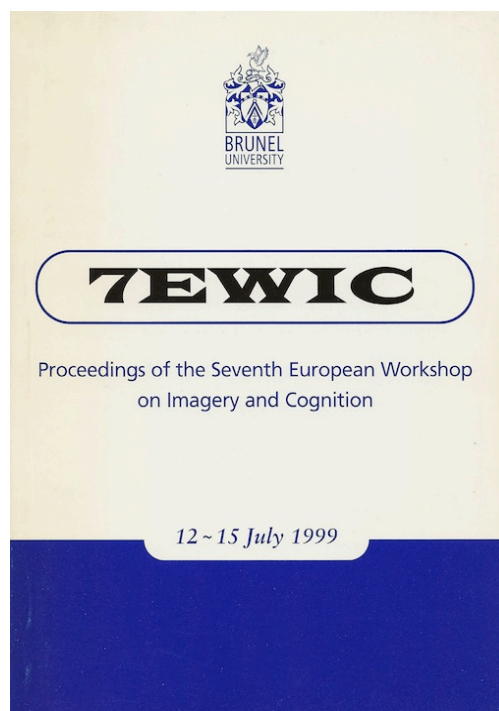

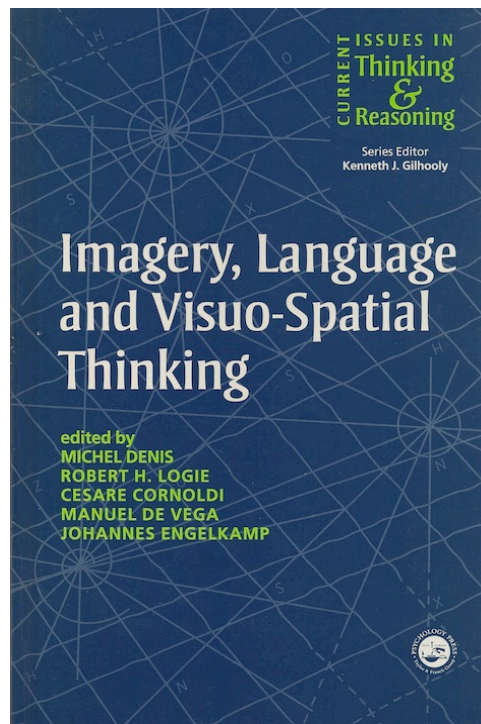
The program included two invited presentations, one by Vicki Bruce (Stirling) and the other by Igor Aleksander (Imperial College of Science, Technology and Medicine, London).
